- Develop program implementation strategies with a focus on human resources, program partnerships, social-emotional learning, and program evaluation.
- Hire, train, and manage the Team Kids program team to execute program logistics, planning, implementation, and evaluation.
- Manage the program budget and participate in annual organizational strategic planning, budgeting, reporting, and fundraising efforts.
- Build and strengthen relationships with program partners in education, public safety, community organizations, and sponsors (individuals, corporations, foundations).
- Collaborate with research partners for pre- and post-program evaluations.
